I. NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS / DEVELOPMENTS

SMP Kolkata participated in Global Maritime Summit (GMIS) 2023

SMP Kolkata participated in GMIS 2023, one of the biggest maritime gatherings in the recent times held from 17th to 19th October, 2023 in Mumbai.

SMPK signed 18 MoUs worth Rs. 36,000 crore at the Meet with several companies, various Government agencies and private partners in areas of port connectivity, capacity augmentation and green energy projects that are components of Vision 2047.


Celebrating Ayurveda at SMP Kolkata

II CARGO THROUGHPUT :

- SMP, Kolkata handled 36.933 million metric tonnes (MMT) of cargo during April - October, 2023 vis-à-vis 36.220 MMT during April -October, 2022, **registering an increase of 1.97 %.**
- HDC handled 27.170 MMT of cargo during April -October, 2023 vis-à-vis 26.864 MMT during April -October, 2022 (an increase of 1.14%). KDS handled 9.763 MMT of cargo in April -October, 2023 vis-à-vis 9.356 mt during April -October, 2022 (**an increase of 4.35%**).
- HDC registered growth in respect of POL (Product), Other Liquid, Vegetable Oil, Iron Ore, Other Coal / Coke (Incl. Petroleum Coke, Metallurgical Coke), Fertilizer Raw Materials, Fly Ash, Container TEUs etc. while KDS registered growth in respect of Finished Fertilizer, Fertilizer Raw Materials, Timber, Other Coal / Coke, Pulses & Peas, Container(both TEUs and Tonnage) etc. during April -October, 2023 vis-à-vis corresponding period of last year.

III CONTAINER TRAFFIC:

SMP, Kolkata handled 441493 TEUs (KDS: 378130 & HDC: 63363) during April - October, 2023 vis-à-vis 395416 TEUs (KDS: 334465 & HDC: 60951) during April - October, 2022, an increase of 11.65%.

IV SHIP TRAFFIC:

During April -October, 2023, 1895 ships (KDS: 729, HDC: 1166) called at SMP, Kolkata vis-a-vis 1745 ships (KDS: 626, HDC: 1119) in April -October, 2022, an increase of 8.60 %. 2331 vessels (1166 inward; 1165 outward) passed through Eden Channel during April -October, 2023 to / from Haldia vis-à-vis 2242 vessels (1119 inward; 1123 outward) during April -October, 2022.

V COMPARATIVE PERFORMANCE :

SMP, Kolkata ranked 1st in handling of Coking/Other Coal, 2nd in handling of Other Liquids and 3rd in handling of Container TEUs & Other Misc. Cargo amongst Indian Major Ports during April to October 2023.

VI RAILWAY TRAFFIC :

During April -October, 2023, SMP, Kolkata handled rail borne cargo of 19.663 MMT (HDC-16.538, KDS- 3.125 MMT) against 20.523 MMT (HDC-17.067 MMT, KDS- 3.456 MMT) in April -October, 2022, registering a fall of 3.10 %. During April -July, 2023, 742 rakes were received and 750 despatched at KDS; at HDC, 3720 rakes were received and 3708 were despatched in the period under review.
