WHEREAS I, the undersigned, am satisfied, for the reasons recorded below that M/s. Gupta Carriers of India, OF 69, Pathuria Ghat Street, Kolkata-700006 is in unauthorized occupation of the Public Premises specified in the Schedule below:

REASONS

FINAL ORDER

21.10.2019.

The matter is taken-up today for Final Disposal. It is the case of Kolkata Port Trust(KoPT) that M/s. Gupta Carriers of India (O.P's) came into occupation of the Port Property in question being land Msg. 65.311 Sq.m., situated on the West side of Sahebbazer Godown at Nimtollah, Kolkata under Plate No. SB-230 as a month to month lessee and thereafter violated the condition of tenancy by way of not paying rental dues to KoPT. It is also the case of KoPT that O.P. has unauthorisedly parted with possession to rank outsiders and therefore, O.P. is liable to pay damages for wrongful use and occupation of the Public Premises after expiry of the period as mentioned in the notice to quit dated 25.08.1972 and was asked to vacate the possession on expiry of the month of October, 1972. It is argued that O.P. has lost its authority to occupy the Public Premises on and from 01.11.1972. This Forum of Law formed its opinion to proceed against O.P. and issued Show Cause Notice u/s 4 of the Act (for adjudication of the prayer for issuing order of eviction etc.) and Show Cause Notice/s u/s 7 of the Act (for adjudication of the prayer for recovery of arrear rental dues etc.) both dated 13.05.2019 as per Rule made under the Act. The Postal Acknowledgement returned undelivered with the remark 'Not Known'. Perused the report of the Process Server dated 17.05.2019 regarding affixation of Show Cause notice/s on the property. I am satisfied with the service of notice to all concerned.

No one appears on behalf of O.P. with proper authority despite service of the Notice/s.

As no reply to the Show Cause Notice/s u/s 4 and 7 of the Act has been filed on behalf of O.P. inspite of repeated chances, I have no other alternative but to issue order of eviction against O.P. of the following grounds/reasons:

I make it clear that all person/s whoever may be in occupation are liable to be evicted by this order and the Port Authority is entitled to claim damages for unauthorized use and enjoyment of the property against O.P. in accordance with Law up to the date of recovery of possession of the same. KoPT is directed to submit a comprehensive status report of the Public Premises in question on inspection of the property after expiry of the 15 days as aforesaid so

In my opinion KoPT's claim for damages upto 31.07.2018 for Rs. 15,41,084/- against Plate No. SB-230 (excluding interest for delayed payment) for wrongful occupation may be payable by O.P. As it is gathered in course of hearing that the charges so claimed by KoPT is on the basis of the Schedule of Rent Charges published under the Authority of Law as per provisions of the Major Port Trusts Act 1963. In course of hearing, I find that KoPT has made out an arguable claim against O.P., founded with sound reasoning. I make it clear that Kolkata Port Trust is to claim damages against O.P. entitled unauthorized use and occupation of the public premises upto the date of recovery of clear, vacant and unencumbered possession of the same in accordance with Law and KoPT is entitled to claim interest upon dues/charges right from the date of incurrence of liability by O.P. as per KoPT's Rule.
