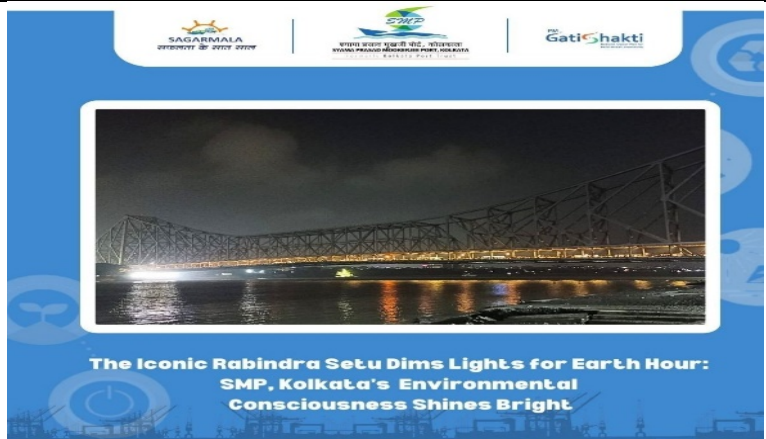
Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port's Commitment to Community Welfare

II CARGO THROUGHPUT :

- SMP, Kolkata handled 4.090 Million Metric Tonnes (MMT) of cargo during April 2024 of FY 2024-25, vis-à-vis 4.666 MMT handled in April 2023. HDC handled 2.993 MMT and KDS 1.097 MMT of cargo respectively during April '24.
- HDC registered growth in respect of LPG, Vegetable Oil, Other Liquid, Other Ore, Limestone, Other Coke, Other Miscellaneous Cargo, etc. while KDS registered growth in respect of Vegetable Oil, Other Liquid, Finished Fertilizer, etc. during April '24 vis-à-vis April '23.

III CONTAINER TRAFFIC:

SMP, Kolkata handled 57,459 TEUs (KDS: 48,237 & HDC: 9,222) during April '24 vis-à-vis 60,863 TEUs (KDS: 49,835 & HDC: 11,028) during April '23, a decline of 5.59%.

IV SHIP TRAFFIC:

During April '24, 252 ships (KDS: 90 HDC: 162) called at SMP, Kolkata vis-a-vis 260 ships (KDS: 104, HDC: 156) in April '23, having a decline of 3.08%. 320 vessels (162 inward; 158 outward) passed through Eden Channel in April '24, to / from Haldia vis-à-vis 319 vessels (156 inward; 163 outward) during April '23.

V COMPARATIVE PERFORMANCE :

SMP, Kolkata ranked 2nd in handling of Other Liquids and 3rd in handling of Coking/Other Coal&Finished Fertiliser amongst Indian Major Ports during April 2024.

VI RAILWAY TRAFFIC :

During April '24, SMP, Kolkata handled rail borne cargo of 2.465 MMT (HDC-2.003, KDS- 0.462 MMT) against 2.806 MMT (HDC-2.37 MMT, KDS: 0.436 MMT) in April '23. During April '24, 110 rakes were received and 115 despatched at KDS; at HDC, 443 rakes were received and 441 were despatched in the month under review.
