


SMP, Kolkata (erstwhile KoPT) Highlights of Achievements in August 2024

I. NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS / DEVELOPMENTS

Launch of "Bengal Middle East Express (BMEx)" by SMPK

SMPK announced the launch of "Bengal Middle East Express (BMEx)", a new container vessel service connecting the Haldia Dock Complex, SMPK with the Jebel Ali Port in the UAE. This service, initiated by Ocean Salute Line of Singapore in partnership with MBK Logistix Pvt Ltd will enhance connectivity for the Port. The inaugural vessel Yong Yue is set to arrive at HDC on 6th of September, 2024. This service is a testament to the commitment made by SMPK for enhancing Port's competitiveness on the global stage and supporting the region's EXIM trade.



The Hon'ble MoS Shri Shantanu Thakur visited Simurali Rest House with Dy. Chairperson, SMPK and other officials. Shri Thakur reviewed the site, learned its History and advised to put up the asset for its best use under Asset Monetisation programme of the Ministry.

Resumption of imports through SMPK fostering cargo growth

Kanpur Edibles Pvt.Ltd. & Mantora Oil Pvt. Ltd. have resumed imports through SMPK after eight years, thus fostering cargo growth at HDC, SMPK. Lower sea freight from Indonesia & Malaysia plus BTPN rakes, ensure smooth delivery from Port to factory.







<u>Participation of SMPK in the Laying of Foundation Stone for 'Vadhvan Port' by the Hon'ble Prime Minister</u>

Chairperson, Dy. Chairperson and other senior officers of KDS & HDC, SMPK witnessed the laying of the foundation stone of the 13th Major Port at Vadhvan on 30th August, 2024 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister. This future mega Port is one of India's biggest upcoming Port under "Viksit Bharat" initiative, comprising of 9 cutting edge Container Terminals, versatile multipurpose berths. This is also a greenfield Port with a 20 metre natural draft.





Completion of 150KW Solar Project at HDC

As part of the 'Go Green Initiative,' HDC, SMPK completed a 150KW solar power project costing around Rs. 2.12 crore on 31.08.2024, aligning with the Government of India's National Action Plan for Climate Change (NAPCC) goal of meeting 60% of the total energy requirement from renewable sources for all Major Ports, thereby reducing the carbon footprint. The commissioning of this project is also part of an initiative to be launched within the first 100 days of the new Government.


Eastern Region EXIM conference

II <u>CARGO THROUGHPUT</u>:

- SMP, Kolkata handled 24.302 million Metric Tonnes (MMT) of cargo during April-August 2024 of FY 2024-25, vis-à-vis 26.428 MMT handled in April-August 2023 of FY 2023-24. HDC handled 18.216 MMT and KDS 6.086 MMT of cargo respectively during April-August '2024.
- HDC registered growth in respect of LPG, Other Liquid, Vegetable Oil, Finished Fertilizer, Limestone, Manganese Ore, Other Ore, Foodgrain, Sugar, Metallurgical Coke, Container Tons and TEUs, etc. while KDS registered growth in respect of Vegetable Oil, Fertilizer Raw Materials, Lime Stone, Iron & Steel, Manganese Ore, Metallurgical Coke, Pulse/Peas, Calcite Chips etc. during April-August '24 vis-à-vis April-August '23.

III CONTAINER TRAFFIC:

SMP, Kolkata handled 3,22,793 TEUs (KDS: 2,57,525 & HDC: 65,268) during April-August '24 vis-à-vis 3,14,498 TEUs (KDS: 2,65,175 & HDC: 49,323) during April-August '23, an increase of 2.64%.

IV SHIP TRAFFIC:

During April-August '24, 1371 ships (KDS: 448; HDC: 923) called at SMP, Kolkata vis-a-vis 1355 ships (KDS: 525, HDC: 830) in April-August '23, having a marginal increase of 1%. 1837 vessels (923 inward; 914 outward) passed through Eden Channel during April-August '24, to / from Haldia compared to 1666 vessels (830 inward; 836 outward) during April-August '23.

V COMPARATIVE PERFORMANCE:

SMP, Kolkata ranked 2nd in handling of Other Liquids & Coking/Other Coal and 3rd in handling of Finished Fertilizer & Other Misc. Cargo amongst Indian Major Ports during April—August 2024.

VI RAILWAY TRAFFIC:

During April-August '24, SMP, Kolkata handled rail borne cargo of 12.154 MMT (HDC-10.017 KDS- 2.137 MMT) against 14.104 MMT (HDC-11.884 MMT, KDS: 2.220 MMT) in April-August '23. During this period, 515 rakes were received and 551 despatched at KDS while at HDC, 2152 rakes were received and 2150 were despatched.
