FINAL ORDER

The matter is taken up to day for final disposal. A brief resume of the fact is necessary to deal with the matter. At the instance of Kolkata Port Trust(KoPT), an opinion was formed by this Forum of Law to proceed against M/s. Janata Mills Stores (O.P) for adjudication of the prayer for recovery of possession etc. in respect of compartment no. K-3 Msg. About 182.369 Sq.m (SW-92) situated at the 2nd floor of KoPT's godown know as Strand Warehouse (previously under monthly lease to O.P. by the Port Authority). An opinion was also formed for initiation of proceedings against O.P. for adjudication of the prayer for recovery of possession in respect of Public Premises being Compartment No. A-1 Msg. about 52.57 Sq.m (SW-46/5) situated at the ground floor of the said Warehouse which was previously under monthly licence as granted to O.P. by the Port Authority . Two Show Cause Notice u/s 4 of the Act both dated 28.08.1993 were issued to O.P. in respect of the Public Premises mentioned above on the grounds as specified therein on the basis of KoPT's application, verified on 21.11.1989 by Tushar Kanti Sen, the then Asst. Land Manager, KoPT. The situation was changed

changed with the application of KoPT dated 14.12.2012 bearing No. Lnd.14/23/12/3750. It is learnt that KoPT's Strand Warehouse has been gutted down by fire on 14.10.02.2010 at about 2.15 A.M. and the structure has been demolished completely. In view of the circumstances by order No. 35 dated 02.01.2013, Proceedings No. 180 of 1993 and 181 of 1993 which were earlier initiated as per Show Notice/s u/s 4 of the Act were dropped and Show Notices u/s 7 of the Act dated 29.01.2013 for adjudication of the prayer for recovery of damages etc. were issued to O.P. in respect of both the premises.

O.P. appeared before this Forum in terms of the Show Cause Notice u/s 7 of the Act which was published in English Daily "The Telegraph" on 09.08.2013 and in Hindi Daily "Sanmarg" on 09.08.2013. I have duly considered O.P's reply to the Show Cause Notice as filed on 07.11.2013, enclosing a photocopy of the representation earlier made to the Land Manager, KoPT dated 14.03.2007. No case has been made out on behalf of O.P. to challenge KoPT's entitlement for recovery of damages as per Show Cause Notice u/s 7 of the Act. In fact, this Forum of Law has no

has no jurisdiction to entertain any matter with regard to prayer for alternative accommodation and to consider any matter on the ground of "financial hardship" as prayed for on behalf of O.P. However, the matter was referred to the Estate Manager, KoPT with liberty to O.P. to approach to the Estate Manager, KoPT for consideration of O.P's prayer in this regard, if any. Perused the KoPT application of bearing 23.11.2015. It Lnd.14/23/15/2625 dated reveals that O.P. failed to make any representation/approach to KoPT in this regard. Such being the case, the only point which is left for consideration whether the claim of KoPT is justified or not. As per Division Bench of the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court's order dated 12.02.2007 in A.P.O. No.367 of 2006 arising out of Writ Petitions moved by the Port Tenant Welfare Association to which O.P. is claiming to be a member of such Association, O.P. is under legal obligation to pay all the dues/charges as payable to KoPT in terms of KoPT's Schedule of Rent Charges for the time being in force by 36 Monthly instalments together with interest at the rate of 6% per annum. mention that O.P. has failed to comply with the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta regarding liquidation of KoPT's dues/charges and KoPT has come up with the applications for eviction of O.P. from the Public Premises etc. in terms of the liberty as provided in the said order passed by the Division Bench of Calcutta High Court. In my view, O.P. being a member of the Port Tenant Welfare Association was protected by the order of the Hon'ble High Court only upon compliance of the said order and failure on the part of O.P. to comply with the order disentitled them to take any protection of the said order. In such a situation, O.P. is under legal obligation to pay the dues/charges as claimed by KoPT on account of damages (such amounts have reached to Rs. 9,63,840 for the period November, 1999 to 14.02.2010 for occupation No. SW92 AND Rs. 5,53,368.29 for the period November,1999 to 14.02.2000 for occupation no. SW 46/5) which attracts interest at the rate of 15% per annum upto 18.09.1996 and thereafter at the rate of 18% per annum upto 06.04.2011 and thereafter at the rate of 14.25% per annum till its liquidation of the same from the date of incurrence of liability in

liability in accordance with the notification of KoPT issued under Authority of Law as per adjustment of payments made so far by O.P as per KoPT's books of accounts.

Accordingly, Department is directed to draw up formal order u/s 7 of the Act, requiring O.P. to pay the said amounts on or before 30.01.2016.

I must reiterate that KoPT's total claim against O.P. on account of charges for compensation for wrongful use and enjoyment of the property has received my due attention and I am satisfied that Port Authority has made out an arguable claim based on sound reasoning for such claim against O.P.

I make it clear that in the event of failure on the part of O.P. to pay the amounts to KoPT as aforesaid, Port Authority is entitled to proceed further for recovery of its claim in accordance with law. All concerned are directed to act accordingly.


