The matter is taken up today for hearing. It is seen that KoPT has again failed to file any application or any documents. It is seen from record that on 19.10.2016, direction was given to KoPT to produce the essential documents for formation of opinion for proceeding against the O.P. under the P.P. Act. Thereafter, numerous opportunities were granted to KoPT but KoPT neither filed a single application nor a single document in support of its claim. Under such circumstances, I do not find any utility in continuing with the proceedings any longer. It appears to me that KoPT has lost all interest in the proceedings.

Under such circumstances, the instant proceedings is dismissed. I make it clear that I have not gone through the merits of the case. KoPT's original application stands disposed of. All concerned are directed to act accordingly.
