The instant proceedings No. 1595/D of 2017 arises out of the application bearing No. Lnd.91/2/II/14/1163 dated 17.07.2014 filed by the Kolkata Port Trust (KoPT), the applicant herein, praying for an order of recovery of compensation/damages and other charges etc. along with accrued interest in respect of the public premises as defined in the Schedule 'A' of the original application, against Shankarlal Beswala & Ors, the O.P herein, under relevant provisions of Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Act, 1971.

The fact of the case in a nutshell is that the O.P. came into occupation of the port property being land measuring 401.525 sq.m. or thereabout situated at Banstala Ghat Road, Ramkrishnapur, Howrah, Thana - Shibpur Police Station, under (Plate No.HL-148) as a lessee on monthly term on fulfilment of certain conditions as embodied in KoPT's offer/letter for allotment. KoPT has submitted that while in possession of the port property as lessee, OP violated the condition of such lease by way of not making the payment of arrear compensation/damages along with interest etc, for use and enjoyment of the Port property in question the details of which has been given in 'Schedule-'B' of the KoPT's

It is also the case of KoPT that O.P has unauthorisedly parted with possession of the said premises to third party, erected unauthorised construction on the subject premises and changed the purpose of such lease without taking prior approval from KoPT.

In view of the aforesaid breaches committed by the O.P., KoPT had issued notice to quit dated 27.04.1973 asking the O.P. to hand over clear, vacant, peaceful and unencumbered possession of the property to KoPT on 01.07.1973. But O.P has failed and neglected to vacate/ hand over the possession of such premises to KoPT after service of the said Notice to Quit. However, now it appears from the record that KoPT has taken over possession of such premises on 16.04.2012. Therefore, O.P. is asked to pay damages/compensation upto 16.04.2012.

Considering the submission and documents as submitted by KoPT, Notice to Show Cause dated 02.08.2017 (vide Order No.1 dated 2.08.2017) was issued by this forum to the O.P. 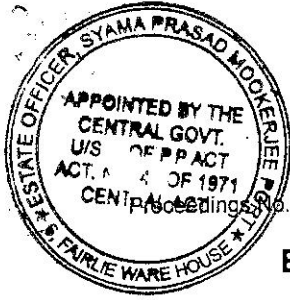

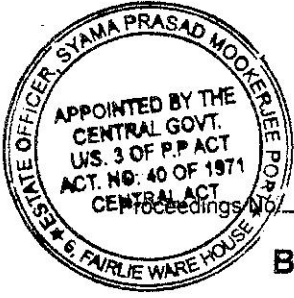
