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FINAL ORDER

The instant proceedings No. 235/D of 1994 arises out of the application filed by the Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port, Kolkata erstwhile Kolkata Port Trust, hereinafter referred to as 'SMP, Kolkata']. the applicant herein, bearing No. Lnd. 2669/3/7/19/108 dated 11.04.2019, praying for an order of recovery of dues on account of Rent and Compensation along with accrued interest thereon in respect of the public premises being the piece or parcel of land measuring about 33.44 sqm or thereabouts situated at the western end of the Trustees' Staff Colony, Taratala Road against Ram Lakhan Upadhyay, (hereinafter referred to as O.P.), under the relevant provisions of Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Act, 1971 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act').

The fact of the case in a nutshell is that the O.P. came into occupation of the said port property/ premises, constituted under occupation no D-377/5, on monthly lease basis. A proceeding was initiated by SMP, Kolkata against the O.P., before this Forum of law, under relevant provisions of the Public Premises Act, for eviction of O.P. from the said premises. The proceeding culminated into an Order of eviction dated 21.11.2005 passed u/s 5 of the Act. Thereafter, the possession of the premises was taken over by SMP, Kolkata on 02.02.2007 in vacant and peaceful condition. Thereafter, SMP, Kolkata vide application dated 11.04.2019 has submitted its claim on account of rent as well as compensation/ mesne profit/ damage charges, which was reportedly due and recoverable from O.P. for its use and enjoyment of the port property in question. After considering the claim of SMP, Kolkata, this Forum formed its opinion to proceed against the O.P. and issued 2 (two) Show Cause Notices, both dated 08.05.2019 (vide Order no 18 dated 24.04.2019), u/s 7 of the Public Premises Act, 1971. The Notices were issued calling upon the O.P. to show cause as to why an order requiring payment of arrear rental as well as

The said Notice was sent through 'Speed Post' to the recorded address of O.P. at 'Ram Lakhan Upadhaya, C/o Deonath Upadhaya, Sonapur Road, Kolkata- 700 027'. The 'Process Server' attached with this Forum for service of such Notices/ Orders etc. has submitted the report dated 10.05.2019 stating that the Notices have been served at the recorded address at the time of visit on 10.05.2019. The Process Server, in his said report dated 10.05.2019, has also submitted that the said notices were affixed on the part of the premises, as per the mandate of the Act.

On the day fixed for hearing of the concerned parties in response to the Show Cause Notice issued, one Shri Prem Adhar Upadhaya appeared before the Forum and introduced himself as the son of Ram Lakhan Upadhyay / O.P., who as per his verbal submission before the Forum, had expired earlier. The said deponent, Shri Prem Adhar Upadhaya did not furnish any Reply to the Show Cause Notice issued by this Forum. Hence, Shri Prem Adhar Upadhaya was advised to submit attested copy of death certificate of his father/ Ram Lakhan Upadhyay / O.P., copy of self attested authentic photo identity proof and other documents to establish his bonafide credentials, viz., that Shri Prem Adhar Upadhaya is the son of Ram Lakhan Upadhyay / O.P. He was also advised to submit his reply to the Show cause Notice to this Forum forthwith, whose acceptance would be subject to his submission/ verification of authenticity of the credentials submitted by him. However, on consecutive dates of scheduled hearing fixed thereafter, viz. on 26.06.2019, 10.07.2019, 24.07.2019 and lastly on 14.08.2019, the said Shri Prem Adhar Upadhaya absented himself from representing the matter before the Forum, despite receipt of order notices. Nor any representative on his behalf or any person interested in the matter attended before this Forum to represent the case. For the sake of natural justice, a number of opportunities were given to the said Prem Adhar Upadhaya to appear and attend this Forum for representation of his case; however, the appearance

of Shri Prem Adhar Upadhaya/ O.P. could not be procured and such efforts remained futile. Considering the situation that the attendance of Shri Prem Adhar Upadhaya/ O.P. could not be procured by this Forum at any point of time inspite of sufficient chances being given to him and even thereafter, this Forum inclined to proceed ex-parte against the O.P.

I find that SMP, Kolkata has produced a statement of accounts dated 09.01.2019 in respect of the said premises in question. It appears from the said statement of accounts that no payment, whatsoever, was made by O.P. in respect of the premises in question for years together. In my view, such statements maintained by a statutory authority/ SMP, Kolkata in its usual course of business has definite evidentiary value, unless challenged by any contender of established credence with fortified documents/evidences etc, ready to bear the test of legal scrutiny. During the course of hearing, I am given to understand by SMP, Kolkata that the rent as well as mesne profit/compensation/ damages, charged from time to time is based on the rates notified by the Tariff Authority for Major Ports (TAMP) in the Official Gazette, which is binding on all users of the port property. Nonpayment of dues by O.P. for years altogether is very much prominent and established, as much as the same has been duly reflected in the official statement of accounts maintained by a statutory authority like SMP, Kolkata during its ordinary course of business, as also in the light of the fact that the same has not been contested/challenged by the O.P./any of his representatives during the various opportunities given to them, during the course of hearing, as iterated above. Hence, I have no bar to accept the veracity of claim of SMP, Kolkata on account of rent and damages/compensation/ mesne profit etc and have nothing to disbelieve in respect of SMP, Kolkata's claim against O.P. as per statement of accounts maintained in SMP, Kolkata's office in its regular course of business.

Thus, it is my considered view that a sum of Rs 3,269.02 (Rupees Three Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Nine and Paise Two only) is

The formal order u/s 7 of the Act is signed accordingly.

I make it clear that in the event of failure on the part of O.P. to pay the dues/charges as aforesaid; SMP, Kolkata is at liberty to recover the dues etc. in accordance with law.

All concerned are directed to act accordingly.
