5. PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

A. Cargo Traffic:

- **Kolkata Port handled 35.045 million tonnes (mt) of traffic in April-October, 2018 vis-à-vis 32.255 mt in Apr-Oct'17 registering a growth of 8.65%, higher than the growth of 5.31% achieved by the Major Ports. HDC handled 24.890 mt in Apr-Oct'18 vis-à-vis 22.294 mt handled in Apr-Oct'17 recording a high growth of 11.64% while KDS handled 10.155 mt in Apr-Oct'18 vis-à-vis 9.961 mt handled in Apr-Oct'17, clocking a growth of 1.95%.**
- **KoPT registered growth in Apr-Oct'18** in respect of LPG, Other Liquid, Rock Phosphate, Limestone, Thermal Coal, Coking Coal, Other Coal/Coke, Iron & Steel, Fly Ash, Salt, Cement Clinker, Coal Tar Pitch, Dolomite, Gypsum, Container, etc.

B. Container Traffic:

- **KoPT handled 4,95,859 TEUs in Apr-Oct'18 vis-à-vis 4,54,494 TEUs in Apr-Oct'17 registering 9.10% growth. KoPT ranked 3rd amongst Major Ports in terms of Container traffic in Apr-Oct'18.**
- **KDS handled 3,90,309 TEUs in Apr-Oct'18 vis-à-vis 3,68,394 TEUs in Apr-Oct'17 – registering a growth of 5.95%. HDC handled 1,05,550 TEUs in Apr-Oct'18 vis-à-vis 86,100 TEUs in Apr-Oct'17 clocking a 22.59% growth.**

C. Comparative Performance:

- **KoPT ranked 1st in Coking/Other Coal, 2nd in Other Liquids and 3rd in Container among Major Ports.**
- **KoPT ranked 6th in cargo handling among Indian Major Ports.**

D. Ship Traffic:

- **In Apr-Oct'18, KoPT handled 2108 ships - the highest among Indian Major Ports.**

E. Railway Traffic:

- **In April-October, 2018, KoPT handled rail-borne traffic of 16.48 mt. (KDS-3.39 mt & HDC-13.09) against 15 mt. (KDS-3.26 mt & HDC-11.74) in April- October, 2017 registering a growth of 9.87%. In April- October, 2018, 808 trains were received and 821 despatched at KDS; at HDC, 2774 trains were received and 2765 were despatched.**

F. Major Achievements:

- In the 148-year history of Kolkata Port Trust, a Cape Size vessel M.V. Samjohn Solidarity, carrying 164928 MT of Dry Bulk cargo (Coal) made a maiden call at Sandheads Anchorage (A/c Adani Enterprises Ltd.) on 17.10.2018. The vessel (LOA : 292.00 metres, Beam : 45.00 metres, Draft : 17.21 metres) discharged around 1 lakh MT of Coal on barges by two Floating Cranes; the entire cargo being discharged was brought to Floating Jetty at Haldia for discharge. After discharging, the vessel to proceed to Paradip for discharge of her remaining cargo.
- On 20.06.2018, the 1st Mini Cape vessel, M.V. Kishore with 54,000 tonnes of cargo arrived at KoPT Sagar Anchorage for the first time and unloading commenced with two recently installed Floating Cranes. Cargo operation at Floating Barge Jetty outside HDC lock gate commenced on 16.6.18 by discharging limestone.
- On the occasion of observance of the Birth Anniversary of Sardar Ballabhbhai Patel as “Rashtriya Ekta Diwas”, KoPT officials took the Unity Pledge on 31.10.18. Unity Run/Walks were organised by Kolkata Port where Shri Vinit Kumar, Chairman, KoPT along with Sr. Officers of KoPT, CISF Jawans, PSO participated.
- On the eve of 'Vigilance Awareness Week', Chairman, KoPT administered the Integrity Pledge to the employees of KoPT. the 2nd Edition of the Vigilance booklet- 'ALOKE' was released by the Chairman, KoPT,
- KoPT commemorated 148 years of its service to the nation at a momentous function held on 26.10.2018 at Rotary Sadan with felicitation of trade/users/Port veterans, followed by cultural programmes.
- Swacchata Pakhwada of KoPT was observed from 16th to 30th September, 2018, through various initiatives, viz. walk to create awareness / Cleanliness Drive / Sharmdan. Joint Swacchata programmes involving Kolkata Port Trust and Tourism Directorate, KMCA, were organized through arrangement of workshops, competitions for school children, plays, paintings by under privileged children, involvement of port users, etc.
- On 17.9.18 Chairman, KoPT, received National Safety Award -Runners Up' for 2016 for 'On shore' & 'On board' categories from Hon'ble Minister of State for Labour & Employment at Dr Ambedkar International Centre, New Delhi. HDC received National Safety Award on 11 occasions earlier.
- Employees of KoPT have contributed one day's salary (Rs.83 lakh) to KCMDRF and relief materials (in containers) were transported free of cost from Kolkata Port to Cochin Port for Kerala flood victims.
- Commemorative function was organized at HDC on 13.8.18 on the occasion of 50 years of cargo handling operation at Haldia which commenced on 13.8.1968.
- The first ever midnight city tour touching the important land and watermarks of the historic port-city of Kolkata, generating huge enthusiasm, was conducted on 16.06.18 and later on 01.10.2018. KoPT has been conducting heritage cruises touching the historic land and water marks of this port-city, viz. the bridges, turrets, ghauts, indenture memorials, museums etc. which have generated considerable public enthusiasm.
- 2615 vessels (1306 inward; 1309 outward) passed through Eden channel in April-October, 2018 to / from Haldia.
