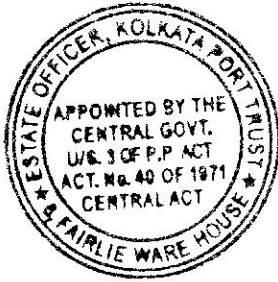

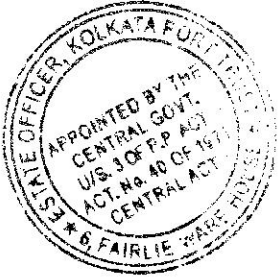

WHEREAS I, the undersigned, am satisfied, for the reasons recorded below that **Mahendra Nath Nayak, of 3, Hide Road, Kolkata- 700 023** is in unauthorized occupation of the Public Premises specified in the Schedule below:

REASONS

1. That O.P. has failed to submit any reply to the Show Cause Notice u/s 4 of the Act inspite of repeated chances.
2. That O.P. has failed to appear before this Forum of Law and has failed to bear any witness or adduce any evidence in support of its authorized occupation into the Public Premises inspite of sufficient chances being given.
3. That O.P. has defaulted in making payment of rental dues to Kolkata Port Trust in gross violation of the condition of tenancy, under monthly term lease as granted by the Port Authority.
4. That O.P. has parted with possession of the premises to rank outsiders in gross violation of the condition of tenancy under monthly term lease as granted by the Port Authority.
5. That O.P. has erected unauthorized structures without prior permission of Kolkata Port Trust in gross violation of the condition of tenancy under monthly terms of lease as granted by the Port Authority.
6. That O.P. has encroached upon Kolkata Port Trust's vacant land, in gross violation of the condition of tenancy under monthly term lease as granted by the port Authority.
7. That O.P. has lost its authority to occupy the Public Premises after expiry of the period as mentioned in the notice of ejection dated 2.11.2011, as issued from the Port Authority.

8. That O.P. could not cite any justifiable grounds to establish the status as "Authorised".
9. That occupation of O.P. (including the occupation of anybody asserting any right through O.P.) has become unauthorised in view of Sec. 2(g) of the P.P. Act.
10. That O.P. is liable to pay damages for its wrongful use and enjoyment of the Port Property in question upto the date of handing over of clear, vacant and unencumbered possession to the Port Authority.

A copy of the reasoned order No.19 dated 04.03.2020 is attached hereto which also forms a part of the reasons.


NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred on me under Sub-Section (1) of Section 5 of the Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorized Occupants) Act, 1971, I hereby order the said Sri. **Mahendra Nath Nayak, of 3, Hide Road, Kolkata-700 023** and all persons who may be in occupation of the said premises or any part thereof to vacate the said premises within 15 days of the date of publication of this order. In the event of refusal or failure to comply with this order within the period specified above the said **Mahendra Nath Nayak, of 3, Hide Road, Kolkata-700 023** and all other persons concerned are liable to be evicted from the said premises, if need be, by the use of such force as may be necessary.

FINAL ORDER

The matter is taken up today for delivering Final Order. It is the case of Kolkata Port Trust (KoPT), Applicant herein that Shri. Mahendra Nath Nayak (O.P) came into occupation of the Public Premises in question with land space measuring 33.445 sqm. (comprised under occupation No. D-377/12) as a month to month lessee and O.P violated the condition of tenancy under the said month to month lease by way of non-payment of rental dues, parting with possession, erecting unauthorised structures and encroaching upon Trustees' khas land. It is argued that O.P. has no authority under law to occupy the Public Premises after expiry of the period as mentioned in the notice of ejectment dated 02.11.2011 as issued upon O.P. by KoPT.

This Forum before issuance of the notices under Section 4 and Section 7 of the Public Premises (Eviction of Unauthorised Occupants) Act, 1971 queried before KoPT whether the O.P. was still alive or not. However, KoPT could not ascertain a response to the query of this Forum, as the Police Authorities, despite ~~of~~ being contacted on several occasions by KoPT, did not reply to KoPT on the said query. An application to this effect has been filed by KoPT on 11.04.2018.

As no information regarding the said query of the Forum was received, this Forum of Law, upon

receipt of other information from the Applicant and being satisfied with the inputs received from KoPT, decided to proceed against O.P. under the relevant provisions of the P.P. Act and issued Show Cause Notice/s u/s 4 of the Act (for adjudication of the prayer for recovery of possession etc. of the Public Premises) and u/s 7 of the Act (for adjudication of the prayer for recovery of arrear rental dues etc.) both being issued as per Rule made under the Act, dated 03.01.2019. O.P. was asked to Show Cause on or before 28.01.2019.

It reveals from records that Postal Service to O.P's address at 3, Hide Road, Kolkata- 700 023 was returned undelivered with remarks of the Postal Department "Addressee cannot be located" on 14.01.2019. I have duly considered the report of the Process Server dated 04.01.2019 regarding Affixation of Notice u/s 4 of the Act on the Public Premises. It has also been stated in the said Report of the Process Server that the premises was found to be under lock and key. However, the order dated 28.01.2019 was duly served on 01.02.2019 upon one Gorakhnath Verma for O.P. upon due signature of the said Gorakhnath Verma on the body of the copy of the order. However, despite having full knowledge of the pendency of the proceedings against the O.P., none appeared on behalf of O.P. or anyone interested into the said

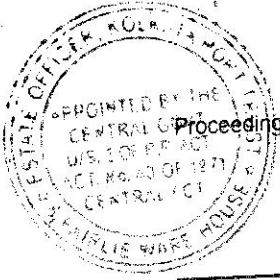
premises, before this Forum for many subsequent dates fixed by it.

On 22.04.2019, this Forum directed publication of order No. 16 dated 22.04.2019 in an English Daily fixing 08.05.2019 as the final date of hearing, failing which the matter was deemed to be decided ex parte. The same was published on 26.04.2019 in 'The Times of India'. In spite of publication of the order in the paper, neither O.P. or anyone else on behalf of O.P. appeared before the Forum to represent their case.

I am satisfied with the service of notice to all concerned interested into the property. In my view, sufficient chances have been given to all concerned to represent their case and O.P. has failed to submit its reply to the Show Cause Notice u/s 4 & 7 of the Act both dated 03.01.2019, in spite of sufficient chances being provided. As no one appeared on behalf of O.P. or on behalf of any person/s interested into the property, in spite of several dates scheduled for hearing and no reply to the Show Cause Notice/s has been filed as yet, I am left with no other alternative but to issue the order of eviction u/s 5 of the Act to O.P. and to all person/s whoever may be in occupation, on the following grounds/reasons:

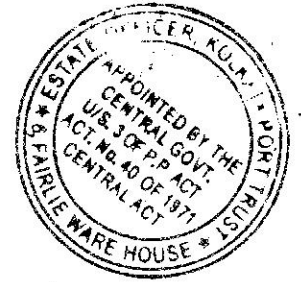

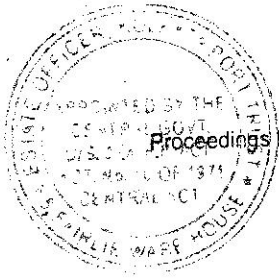

ACCORDINGLY, Department is directed to draw up formal order of eviction u/s.5 of the Act as per Rules made there-under, giving 15 day's time to O.P. and any person/s, whoever may be in occupation to vacate the premises. I make it clear that all person/s, whoever may be in occupation are liable to be evicted by this order and the Port Authority is entitled to claim damages for unauthorized use and enjoyment of the property against O.P. in accordance with Law up to the date of recovery of possession of the same.

It is my considered view that a sum of Rs.3,85,322.99/- (Rupees Three lakhs eighty five thousand three hundred twenty two and ninety

nine paise only) for the period 01.09.1982 to 30.11.2011 is due and recoverable from O.P. by the Port authority on account of rental dues and O.P. must have to pay the rental dues to KoPT on or before 25.03.2020. Such dues attract interest at the rate of 15% per annum upto 18.09.1996, at the rate of 18% per annum upto 06.04.2011 and thereafter at the rate of 14.25% per annum till liquidation of the same from the date of incurrence of liability, in accordance with the notification of KoPT issued under Authority of Law, as per KoPT's books of accounts. Department is directed to draw up formal order as per Rule u/s 7 of the Act.

In my considered view, KoPT's claim for damages from 01.12.2011 to 30.04.2018 for Rs. 5,11,167.00 (Rupees Five lakhs eleven thousand one hundred and sixty seven only)(excluding interest for delayed payment) for wrongful occupation must be payable by O.P. as it is gathered, during the course of hearing and application dated 25.04.2018, filed by KoPT that the charges so claimed by KoPT are on the basis of the Schedule of Rent Charges published under the Authority of Law, as per provisions of the Major Port Trusts Act 1963.

Likewise I find that KoPT has made out an arguable claim against O.P., founded with sound reasoning regarding damages/compensation to be paid for unauthorized occupation. As such, I must say that 5,11,167.00 (Rupees Five lakhs eleven

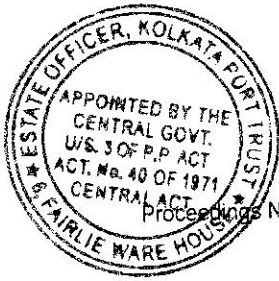
