1. Pre-qualification Criteria:

- A. The intending bidder should have successfully completed any CIVIL ENGINEERING WORK during last 7 years ending on the last day of the month previous to the one in which applications are invited and the value of completed work(s) should be either of the following :-
- a) Three similar works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated amount put to tender.
- b) Two similar works each costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated amount put to
- c) One similar work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated amount put to tender.
- B. The average Annual Financial turnover of the intending tenderer during the last 3 years ending 31st March of the last financial year [2015-2016] should be at least 30% of the estimated amount put to tender.
- 2. The Trustees' General Conditions of Contract, Schedules of Rates may be seen at this office during office hours on any working day. The GCC is also available on Ko.P.T's website. Rest of the tender documents like Special Conditions of Contract, B.O.Q. etc. are attached herewith.
- 3. In case of a tenderer who has already deposited a Permanent Security with the KoPT under the new rules, he shall be bound by the Clauses of the General Conditions of the Contract pertaining to Earnest Money and Security Deposits for Registered Contractors.

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4. The tenderer who is tendering beyond his financial limit as per class of enlistment with KoPT, is required to deposit the Earnest Money Deposit in the form of Bankers' cheque / Demand Draft / Pay order in favour of "KOLKATA PORT TRUST" on any Schedule Bank payable at Kolkata before submission of the tender. The original Bankers' cheque / Demand Draft / Pay order must be attached with the tender without which the tender may be disqualified.

- <u>5.</u> The EMD amount will be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderer without **any interest**. In case of being the successful tenderer, this amount will be adjusted against the Security Deposit as per the relevant clause of the G.C.C. Tender offer without EMD will be rejected.
- <u>6.</u> The rate quoted by the Contractor must be valid up to four months from the date of opening of tender.
- <u>7.</u> The rate quoted by the tenderer should be complete in all respect and should include all duties, taxes, octroi, surcharge etc except Service Tax.
- <u>8.</u> While quoting the rate it should be noted that the tenderer should on no account overwrite the figures. Any correction necessary, should be made by cancelling the original figures and writing the corrected figures on the top. All such corrections should be initialled by the tenderer. If the figures are tampered with, the tender shall be liable to be rejected.
- 9. The tender duly filled in, quoted and signed along with the following documents shall be submitted in sealed cover superscribing the above name of work so as to reach this office within 3:00 P.M. on 03/07/2017. The tender will be opened shortly after 3:00 P.M, on the same day and intending bidders or their authorised representatives may attend the same. In the event of any unforeseen circumstances such as holidays, bandhs, strikes etc., on that day, the tenders may be submitted by 3:00 P.M. on the next working day, and will be opened shortly after 3 P.M. on the same day. All other conditions shall remain the same.
 - i. Bankers cheque / Demand Draft / Pay Order for Earnest Money or copy of Treasury receipt for permanent Security Deposit.
 - ii. Cost of tender documents.

- 10. All tenderers should enclose a check list duly filled up enclosing the relevant documents as per the proforma attached with the tender documents. If the tenderer fails to submit such check list duly filled up, the tender would not be considered for opening. If contents of check list turn out to be misrepresentation of facts, then such bids would be rejected even after opening of price bid with a recorded warning for the bidder.
 - Proforma check list (Annexure marked A) should be attached as a covering letter along with the sealed envelope containing the offer.
- 11. The tenderer must return the tender document duly filled in and signed in all pages with his office seal. The tenderer shall not impose his own terms and conditions. Such a tender shall be rejected.
- 12. The undersigned does not bind him to accept the lowest or any tender or to assign any reason there for and also reserve the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders in part or whole.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- General:-These conditions are part of the tender documents, which must be read as a whole, the various sections being complimentary to one another, and are to be taken as mutually explanatory. Special Conditions of Contract shall be read in conjunction with the General Conditions of Contract, Instructions to Bidders, Bill of Quantities and other documents forming part of this Contract. If the stipulations in the various tender documents be found to be at variance in any respect, one will override others (but only to the extent these are at variance) in the order of precedence as given in the list below, i.e. any particular item in the list will take precedence over all those placed lower down in the list.
 - Order letter.
 - o Bill of Quantities.
 - o Drawings (if any).
 - Special Conditions of the Contract.
 - o General Conditions of Contract.

In case of any dispute, question or difference either during the execution of the work or any other time as to any matter or thing connected with or arising out of this Contract, the decision of the Engineer shall be final and binding.

 Scope Of Work: Scope of the work comprises of dismantling one small damaged unused room at North side gate, painting at Main gates, cleaning of rubbish and unwanted materials from inside road berms, development of garden beside north side gate, construction of one RCC column and west side part of the M. S Gate at south side entrance including all other appurtenant works at Portland Park.

The intending tenderer shall inspect the site of work in consultation with Superintending Engineer (Civil), South Section and acquaint himself with the nature of work before preparing his tender. His attention is drawn to Clause No. 3.1 of the General Conditions of Contract in this regard. No excuse on ignorance as to the site conditions, availability of space for storing materials and approaches to site etc., will be entertained.

Unless otherwise specified, the work to be provided for by the contractor shall include but not be limited to the following:-

- (i) Providing all materials, supervision, services, equipments , tools , plants , scaffolding, transportation, consumables , water supply, necessary approaches, temporary works including barricading / guarding , illumination and temporary lighting , as required for safety and work purposes etc
- (ii)To exercise rigid quality control in execution of the work and to carry out sampling, testing, and furnishing the test results to the Engineer for the quality of construction materials and the quality of the work done.
- (iii)Making good any damage done to Trustees' property during execution of work.
- 3. Work Site: The work site is located at Portland Park. The tenderer shall visit the site of works and acquaint himself with the exact nature, scope and site of work before quoting his rates. No claims for any extra payment will be entertained under any circumstances after opening of the tender on this account. The contractor shall bear in mind that least possible inconvenience is to be caused to the occupants of the residential area.
- 4. Working Period: Normally the work will be carried out between 8 A.M. to 5 P.M. However, the tenderer should note that he might be required to carry out the job beyond the normal working hours including at night to complete the same within the stipulated period of completion. The tenderer should include in his rates the cost, if any, involved on these accounts.
- 5. <u>Time of Completion</u>: The work is urgent in nature and is required to be completed within $1 \& \frac{1}{2}$ (one and half) month from the date of placement of work order including preliminary time.

- 6. <u>Site Godown and Watching:</u> The contractor shall have to make his own arrangements for construction of site godown (if any) for storage of materials and security thereof during day and night at his own cost. The godown and other temporary structures, if erected, are to be dismantled by the contractor before leaving the site after completion of the work at his own cost to leave the site at its initial condition. The Trustees' will, however, allow the construction of godown on the Trustees' land free of rent during execution of the work.
- 7. Forwarding of Materials: All dismantled unserviceable materials are to be disposed off beyond the office compound and in conformity with the Municipal/ Corporation Rules at the contractor's own cost. The contractor shall have to arrange transport for forwarding any usable/ saleable materials that may be found during the process of execution of the work to the Trustees' Sales Yard or any other Site/ Godown including labourers, transportations, loading, unloading all complete as per the direction of the Engineer's representative. No separate payment will be made to the contractor on this account unless specifically mentioned in the B.O.Q.
- 8. <u>Water:</u> The contractor shall make his own arrangement for supplying of water for construction purposes as well as for drinking for his workmen at his own cost. However efforts may be made to give some water connection near to the site for drinking purpose only, free of cost.
- 9. <u>Specifications/ Codes and Standards</u>: All works under this contract will be executed according to the Trustees' Specification for materials and workmanship. Whenever the details are not specifically covered in the specifications, relevant provisions in the latest revision and/ or replacements of the Indian Standard Specifications (IS) or in absence CPWD specifications will be followed. The Contractor shall have to procure copies of such codes/ standards for ready reference of his own personnel as well as the Trustees' Engineers at site at his own cost and without any additional reimbursement.
- 10. <u>Materials and Transport</u>: All materials required for successful completion of work shall have to be procured and supplied by the successful tenderer at his own cost. The materials supplied by the contractor shall be of approved quality and approval also shall have to be taken from the Engineer before using the materials to the work. Rejected materials, if any, shall have to be removed by the contractor with his own labour and transport at his own cost immediately on receipt of the instruction.
- 11. <u>Testing of materials</u>: Testing of any material including cement shall have to be carried out at the authorised / renowned testing facilities acceptable to the Engineer's representative. No additional payment will however be made to the contractor towards charges for testing which are not mentioned in the BOQ but to be done as per the codes and specifications.
- 12. <u>Supervision:</u> The contractor shall have to engage sufficient number of qualified and skilled persons to supervise and execute the work. The contractor shall solely be responsible for any defective construction/ rectification as a result of poor supervision.
- 13. <u>Escalation/ variation in Prices:</u> No escalation/ variation on prices of labour as well as materials will be considered for payment.
- 14. Errors in the B.O.Q:In case rate of particular item is printed erroneously in BOQ, the rate stated in the Schedule of rates will prevail over the rate misprinted in BOQ.
- 15. <u>Electricity</u>: Necessary arrangement for electrical connection, if required for the work shall be provided by Ko.P.T on chargeable basis at prevalent rates.
- 16. Compliance to the Labour Laws and Contract Labour Regulation and Abolition Act, 1970:

The contractor shall be required to comply with the Minimum Wages Acts 1948, Employees Liability Act, 1938, Industrial Dispute Act, 1940 and the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970, or statuary amendments and the modifications thereof, any other laws relating thereto and the rules made there under from time to time. The successful bidder i.e. the contractor shall be required to pay the labourers the higher of (a) daily Minimum Wage applicable for respective category of labourers in Kolkata [i.e area A] as notified through relevant circular of CLC (Central), Govt. Of India and (b) daily Minimum Wage applicable for corresponding category of labourer in Kolkata as per Govt. Of West Bengal Minimum Wage circular, applicable for the relevant period. The contractor shall also be required to pay EPF & ESI contribution for his employees for the subject contract and if instructed by the Engineer, documentary evidence regarding payment of EPF & ESI contribution may have to be submitted for verification. It will be the duty of the contractor to abide by the provisions of the all the Acts, Ordinances, Rules, Regulations, Byelaws and Procedures as are lawfully necessary in the execution of the works. The contractor will be

fully responsible for any delay / damage etc. and keep the Engineer indemnified against all penalties and liabilities of any kind for noncompliance or infringement of such Acts, Ordinances, Rules, Regulations Byelaws and Procedures. The contractor shall indemnify the Ko.P.T against payment to be made under or for the observance of the laws aforesaid without prejudice to his right to claim indemnity from his subcontractor.

The aforesaid regulations shall be deemed to be a part of this contract and any breach thereof shall be deemed to be a Breach of Contract. It will be obligatory on the part of contractor to obtain necessary Labour License from the Competent Authority for deploying requisite nos. of labours in the work and submit to the Engineer-in-Charge prior to commencement of the work.

L7. Security Restrictions: - Keeping in mind the security rules and regulations applicable at Trustees' offices / other premises regarding entry and exit, the successful tenderer shall arrange for necessary permit / ensuring identity of workmen as and when required for men , material and vehicle at no extra cost to the Trustees.

18. Rate for payment against extra Items of works :-

For any unforeseen work not covered under the Bill of Quantities and Condition of Contract, depending on contingent situation at site, if required for successful completion of the work, extra items have to be carried out by the Contractor. If those items are already available in Trustees' Schedule of rate, payment will be made on the basis of Trustees' Schedule of Rates including accepted contractual percentage otherwise:-

- (i) The rate of payment of work involving labour & material shall be fixed on the following basis:
 - a) Cost of materials consumed including transport and wastage, plus
 - b) Cost of labour actually engaged in the works, plus
 - c) Taxes and Duties as applicable, plus
 - d) 16 % on the aggregate of (a) and (b) towards overhead, profit and cess.
- (ii) For any work involving only labour, rate of payment shall be fixed on cost of labour actually engaged in the work plus $11\ \%$ towards profit and cess.
- (iii) For only supply of any material at site, rate of payment shall be fixed on actual cost of material plus transport, loading & unloading (if any) plus 11 % towards profit and cess.
- L9. Service Tax: The rate quoted by the tenderer should be considered to complete the work in all respect and should include all taxes, octroi, surcharge etc. (except service taxe) payable to Government or any other concern and no extra payment, whatsoever will be entertained by the Trustees' under any circumstances. As Ko.P.T is not a Registered Body Corporate, it is not liable to pay Service Tax under 'Reverse Charge Mechanism' as per Service Tax Law. Service Tax, if leviable, will be paid extra by the Trustees as applicable. The bidder shall not include Service Tax in his rates. In case Service Tax is payable, the Contractor will be required to submit necessary bill/ challans/ invoice in accordance with Service Tax Rules and the Contractor needs to be registered with the Central Excise for the service to be rendered and copy of the same shall be submitted to Ko.P.T. On demand, the successful bidder will have to submit documents regarding payment of Service Tax.Regarding delay / extension of time/ Liquidated damages for delay / Termination of Contract, necessary action shall be taken as per relevant provisions of the Trustees' General Conditions of Contract.

PREAMBLE TO THE BILL OF QUANTITIES

- 2. The quantities given in the Bill of Quantities are approximate only and are given to provide a common basis for tendering. Payment will be made according to the quantities of each item of work actually carried out at the accepted rates as per Order Letter. The Engineer or his Representative shall measure the measurements of each item of work jointly.
- 3. This being a percentage rate tender, the Bidder shall quote his rates as percentage above / below / at par with the estimated amount put to tender properly based on his own analysis in the 'ABSTRACT FORM OF TENDER' both in words and in figures.
- 4. In such cases, if arithmetical error is committed by the tenderer in working out the amount, the tendered percentage shall be taken into account and the amount corrected and the corrections authenticated by the tenderer.
- 5. When there is a difference between the percentage quoted in words and in figures, the percentage rate which complies with the amount worked out by the tenderer for this amount shall be taken as correct.
